

## MINUTES

South Lebanon Township  
June 23, 2015

1. The meeting of the South Lebanon Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman Robert Arnold, with all members, Township Manager, Township Solicitor, Fire Chief and five (5) visitors present.
2. Chairman Robert Arnold led the group in saluting the flag.
3. VISITORS:
  - A. One (1) visitor was present to observe the meeting for his Boy Scout "Communication Merit Badge".
  - B. Four (4) visitors were present to observe the meeting.
4. MINUTES:
  - A. The Minutes of the June 9, 2015 meeting were read and approved on motion by David Eggert, seconded by Stephen Krause. Motion passed unanimously.
5. REPORTS:
  - A. The Fire Department Report showing 41 fire calls for the month of May was read and approved on motion by Stephen Krause, seconded by David Eggert. Motion passed unanimously.
  - B. The Property Maintenance Code Report for the month of May was read and accepted on motion by Stephen Krause, seconded by Robert Arnold. Motion passed unanimously.
6. COMMUNICATIONS:
  - A. The Board read a letter from the Lebanon Valley College Ultimate Frisbee Club, requesting permission to utilize South Hills Park to host a Community Hat Frisbee Tournament on July 25, 2015. Permission was granted on motion by David Eggert, seconded by Stephen Krause. Motion passed unanimously.
  - B. The Board read a letter from Cornwall Borough Police Department, requesting South Lebanon Township Fire Police assistance for the Mt. Gretna Art Show on August 15-16, 2015. Permission was granted on motion by Stephen Krause, seconded by David Eggert. Motion passed unanimously.
7. OLD BUSINESS:
  - A. The Board discussed the Meadowview Estates public sewer survey results and information obtained regarding on lot sewer repairs in the development.
8. NEW BUSINESS:
  - A. The Board hired Mark Wolf as a seasonal part-time South Hills Park employee on motion by David Eggert, seconded by Stephen Krause. Motion passed unanimously.
  - B. The Board reviewed and has no objection to the Stephen and Brenda Miller petition for variance to be presented to the Zoning Hearing Board on July 13, 2015.
  - C. The Board presented a plaque and a clock to Robert Arnold in recognition of his 35 years of service as Chairman and member of the South Lebanon Township Board of Supervisors and Authority.
