

## MEETING

South Lebanon Township  
August 22, 2017  
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1. The meeting of the South Lebanon Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman David Eggert, with all members, Township Manager, Assistant Township Manager, Public Works Director, Township Solicitor, and five (5) visitors present.
2. Chairman David Eggert led the group in saluting the flag.
3. VISITORS:
  - A. Two residents were present and were provided an update on the progress made on the situation at 3 Folmer Street. Items have been removed from 3 Folmer Street and professional exterminating services have begun at both properties.
  - B. Logan Yiengst, Huntlar Corporation, was present to observe action under New Business, Item A.
  - C. Two residents were present to observe the meeting.
4. MINUTES:
  - A. The Minutes of the meeting held on August 8, 2017 were read and approved on motion by Stephen Krause, seconded by David Eggert. Motion passed with Jonathan Beers abstaining due to not attending the August 8, 2017 meeting.
5. REPORTS:
  - A. The Fire Department Report, showing 35 calls during the month of July, was read and accepted on motion by Jonathan Beers, seconded by Stephen Krause. Motion passed unanimously.
  - B. The Property Maintenance Code Report for the month of July was read and accepted on motion by Stephen Krause, seconded by Jonathan Beers. Motion passed unanimously.
6. COMMUNICATIONS:
  - A. The Board read a letter from the American Heart Association requesting South Lebanon Township Fire Police assistance at their 2017 Annual Heart Walk on September 24, 2017. The request was

approved on motion by Jonathan Beers, seconded by Stephen Krause. Motion passed unanimously.

- B. The Board read a letter from the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation requesting permission to utilize South Hills Park for their 2018 Great Strides Walk event to be held on May 5, 2018. Permission was granted on motion by Stephen Krause, seconded by Jonathan Beers. Motion passed unanimously.
- C. The Board read a letter from Lebanon County Emergency Management Agency stating the County Commissioners secured a grant to update the Lebanon County Hazard Mitigation Plan. Municipalities will be requested to participate in meetings over the next 14 months. The updated plan will be available for municipalities to adopt as Municipal Hazard Mitigation Plans.

7. OLD BUSINESS:

- A. Bids for the sale of used Township equipment per the attached page were approved on motion by Jonathan Beers, seconded by Stephen Krause. Motion passed unanimously.

8. NEW BUSINESS:

- A. Bids submitted for the demolition and lot restoration at 743 Kiner Avenue were opened as follows:
  - a. SDL Construction LLC - \$14,600.00
  - b. Huntilar Corporation - \$22,222.00

The bids were accepted and moved for tabulation on motion by Stephen Krause, seconded by Jonathan Beers. Motion passed unanimously.

- 9. Bills amounting to \$366,556.91 were individually examined and approved for payment on motion by Jonathan Beers, seconded by Stephen Krause. Motion passed unanimously.

- 10. The meeting was adjourned at 7:14 p.m. by Chairman David Eggert.
