

Free Trees

The Penn State Agriculture and Environment Center is pleased to be able to offer free trees to landowners for the 6th year in a row through support by the National Fish and Wildlife Foundation. The trees are available to landowners interested in planting riparian buffers or converting turf-to-trees. We are in search of organizations and landowners who may be interested in planting trees on their properties this fall.

All landowners within Lebanon, Lancaster, and Dauphin Counties are eligible for this program, however we are prioritizing projects that fall with the Chiques Creek watershed. The trees are provided at no cost but planting and maintenance are the responsibility of the recipient.

Stock is limited and will be given out based on a ranking system that takes into account size, location, and environmental benefits of project proposals and a site visit will be required as part of the approval process.
